



Chemical Science Incursion

Dear Parents,

During Week 6 of this Term, Rebecca Hengemuhle from *ScienTech*, will be conducting a Chemical Science Incursion for our school. Classes will be immersed in the captivating world of science while having fun.

During this incursion children will explore the effects of liquid nitrogen on various objects to generate an interest and curiosity about Science. They will explore chemical reactions, physical changes and more. Activities are based upon the Victorian Curriculum and designed to be engaging and hands on.

Prep-Grade 2 students will explore how everyday materials can be physically changed with other materials. They will pose questions, make predictions and record their observations.

Grades 3-4 will observe the changes in states between solid and liquid by adding and removing heat. They will investigate questions, make predictions and reflect upon their results.

Grades 5-6 will observe changes to materials and how they can be reversible or irreversible. They will use their prior knowledge to pose questions, make predictions and then decide which variables could be changed based upon the results of the experiment.

The cost of this hands experience will be \$4:50 per student and it is expected that all children participate as follow up work will continue in class.
