Research has found that children that read at home (including shared reading) have higher vocabulary levels, better literacy skills, increased comprehension and improved listening skills. Further to this, we will be encouraging all students to learn their multiplication tables for Maths homework.

Spelling will continue to consist of our weekly list that is taken from the Soundwave program that we are learning in class.
