

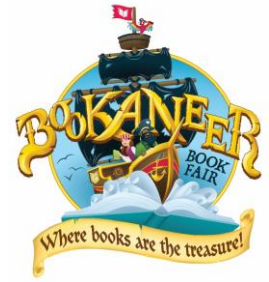
# Book Fair 2017
