



BOOKLIST INFORMATION 2017

Dear Parents,

Please find below all information regarding all school costs for the commencement of the 2017 school year. If you would like further explanation of these details please contact me at the school.

Please note that our process for student stationery packs has changed for 2017. You will not be required to collect your child's stationery pack from the school office. All packs will be sent directly to your child's classroom where the teacher will store them and distribute items when required.

1. BOOKLIST BREAKDOWN

1.1. Stationery Items :

Individual stationery packs will be ordered for your child, and sent directly to your child's classroom. The contents of the packs are determined by class teacher to suit each year level

Essential Education Program Materials:

The following items are purchased in bulk by the school and distributed to your child throughout the year

- Consumable materials used by your child in the classroom which the school is able to buy in bulk (eg. paint, coloured paper, glue, printing costs)
- Specialist Areas such as Visual Arts, Performing Arts, ICT (eg. paint, coloured paper, glue, printing costs)
- Mathematics online maths program
- Soundwaves

1.2. PARENT VOLUNTARY CURRICULUM CONTRIBUTION

The voluntary contribution assists us to offer extra curricula programs and activities such as the Connected Kids program, Student Leadership Program and the Chaplaincy Program. It also assists us to have the latest ICT infrastructure such as computers, netbooks, interactive whiteboards. You can choose from any of the options under that heading or choose an amount that suits your financial situation

1.3. PARENT VOLUNTARY BUILDING & GROUNDS CONTRIBUTION

This contribution is being kept as low as possible and is used to partly cover the cost of the employment of a handyman and gardener. This ensures that our buildings and grounds are kept in a pristine condition, without relying on parent assistance through school working bees. You can choose from any of the options under that heading or choose an amount that suits your financial situation.

2. OTHER ITEMS REQUIRED

2.1. Art Smocks :

All students require an art smock for Visual Arts, These can be ordered from Beleza, or an old adult shirt will serve the purpose for an art smock. (note: the material needs to be thick so that the paint doesn't soak through).

2.2. Tissues:

All students are required to bring a large box of tissues to school for Personal use.

2.3. Take Home Reader Bag

All Junior School students will require a sturdy, waterproof bag for their take home reader. The school

sells a waterproof nylon, Velcro fastened reader bag with a handle for \$15.00. These very sturdy bags should last your child's time at primary school. The bags will have the Somerville Rise Primary School logo on them and are available from the school office.

2.6 Broad Rimmed or Legionnaires Hat

All students are required to wear a sun smart hat. Hats are available from Beleza Uniform shop.

2.7 Sunscreen

As part of our Sunsmart policy students are requested to supply and be responsible for their own sunscreen.

2.8 Headphones

All students will be required to have their own lightweight over the ear headphone set.

The school is able to purchase the headphones in bulk and will be available for sale from the school office at a cost of \$ 12.00

2.9 Library Bag.

All students will require a library bag
