EXCURSION DETAILS:	Students in grades 5 and 6 who have been selected to play in a Summer Sport School team will compete against other schools from the Murdoch District. The sports played are Kanga 8's, Softball, Rounders and Newcomb.
EXCURSION DATES:	24 <sup>th</sup> of February, 3 <sup>rd</sup> and 10 <sup>th</sup> of March. <b>We have a Lightning Premiership Day this year, a note and payment envelope will be sent home in a few weeks.</b>
COST & CLOSING DATE:	<b>\$5</b> per student which is due in full by <b>Wednesday the 22<sup>nd</sup> of February.</b> Please complete the attached envelope (ensuring you sign the back) with correct money. <b>The Lightning Premiership day is not included in this fee.</b>
DEPARTURE/RETURN TIMES:	Students playing in the AWAY games will be leaving school at 9.10am and returning to school at 11am. Each week we will have some teams playing at HOME and the others will play AWAY. This is because schools can't cater for all the games being played at the one venue. <b>A fixture is on the back of this note.</b>

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS:	Students will be travelling to and from the venue by Driver Bus Service
STUDENT INDEMNITY:	By signing the payment envelope I understand that I have given my authority for the teacher in charge of the excursion to consent, where it is impracticable to communicate with me, to the child receiving such medical or surgical treatment as may be deemed necessary and payment of any expenses thus incurred.
FURTHER INFORMATION:	Students will be required to wear full school uniform and wear appropriate footwear for their sport. They should also have a water bottle and school hat.
STUDENT BEHAVIOUR:	I understand that in the event of my son's/daughter's misbehaviour or behaviour that poses a danger to himself/herself or others during the excursion, he/she may be sent home. I further understand that in such circumstances I will be informed and that any costs associated with his/her return will be my responsibility.
CONSENT TO EMERGENCY TRANSPORTATION:	In the event of an emergency I consent to my child being transported in a privately owned vehicle driven by a member of the supervisory staff listed above.
STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE:	The Department of Education does not provide student accident cover including ambulance cover. Parents may wish to obtain student accident insurance cover from a commercial insurer, depending on their health insurance arrangements and any other personal considerations. Parents are also advised to ensure that they have ambulance cover as the school will not hesitate in calling an ambulance if required
