<p><b>Reading</b></p> <p>Read for 10 -15 minutes <u>AT LEAST eight</u> times during this period.  <u>Record your reading on your reading log sheet in your homework book.</u> Remember to include page numbers if you are reading long books.            Try to read a variety of books.</p>	<p>Write a letter or send an email to your teacher telling them about one thing you did over the holidays.</p>	<p>Are all the clocks in your house set to the correct time? Phone 1194 and check. Then reset them if they are not correct.            (Get permission first).            Record what you did in your homework book.</p>
<p><b>Spelling</b></p> <p>Do LSCWC <u>four</u> times (one column a day)</p> <p>Week One words - sound focus - "Nanny has a net" (n, nn, kn) and "Ring on the finger" (n ng)</p> <p>Week Two words - sound focus - "I saw a boat" (o, oa, oe, ow)</p>	<p>Make a card, write a letter or send an email to someone who did something nice for you over the holidays.            Record what you did in your homework book.</p>	<p>Pretend you are going out for a day. You have to set up your tv to record 3 hours of tv viewing. Get a tv guide from a newspaper or online. In your homework book write down what shows you would want to record, including details like name of show, start and finish time and channel.</p>
<p><b>Numeracy</b></p> <p>Practise counting. Chose some counting patterns you need to work on eg 2s (starting with odds and evens), 3s, 4s, 5s, 6s, 7s, 8s, 9s, 10s. Start at numbers other than 0. Count forwards and backwards.            Record your work in your homework book.</p>	<p>Write a letter to an author telling them why you like their books. (You don't have to actually send this.)            This can be typed or handwritten. Include the letter in your homework book.</p>	<p>Fill in a diary for at least three days showing how you spend your time including hours in bed, at school, special events (eg footy training and games, swimming or dance lessons etc).</p>
