Catching on Early & Respectful Relationships Topic 7	
Week 1 17 July 2019	Lesson 1: Introduction to Puberty (growing and changing) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I can describe and talk about similarities and differences in the way people grow. - Compare changes in boys and girls during puberty.
Week 2 24 July 2019	Lesson 2: Body Parts (growing and changing) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I can label the reproductive body parts for females and males - I understand the importance of using the correct scientific terminology
Week 3 31 July 2019	Lesson 3: The amazing story of conception (where did I come from?) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I know how babies are conceived, develop and are born as part of the human life cycle - There are different ways of getting pregnant and joining a sperm with an egg (through intercourse or with the help of a doctor)
Week 4 7 August 2019	Lesson 4: Qualities of Friendship (belonging) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I know that a friend is someone I like to spend more time with and we share some of the same interests - I know how friends should treat me, by taking turns and playing fair - Friends also have disagreements and we can learn strategies to sort those out
Week 5 14 August 2019	Lesson 5: Keeping Safe <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I know that some touches are okay and others touches are not - I know how to keep safe during a relationship (avoiding pregnancy, disease, etc)
Week 6 21 August 2019	Lesson 6: Born or made? Thinking about gender <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I can describe the way in which gender influences how people relate to young children
Week 7 28 August 2019	Lesson 7: From words to actions <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I understand the difference between the terms sex and gender - I understand the difference between same-sex attracted, heterosexual and transgender - I can identify actions that children and adults can take to contribute to a respectful, friendly, inclusive school
Week 8 4 September 2019	Lesson 8: Gender norms in early adolescence <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I can identify the ways in which gender norms can influence boys and girls as they enter early adolescence - I can identify strategies that some peers and adults may use to reinforce or police limiting gender norms
Week 9 11 September 2019	Lesson 9: Facts about gender and opportunity <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I can use data to identify the ways in which inequitable gender norms and discrimination operate to limit the opportunities some people have to participate fully and equally in life
Week 10 18 September 2019	Lesson 10: The Inter-generational gender machine <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I can explore how gender norms are transmitted through intergenerational cultural practices - I can identify how gender norms change over time
