EXCURSION DETAILS:	The Year 2 camp day will be held at Somers Camp where students will be involved in activities such as orienteering, low rope courses and mini golf. The day will start at 8.00am with breakfast, which will be provided at school, followed by an outdoor activity before leaving for Somers.

DEPARTURE/RETURN TIMES:	<b>Students are required to be at school at 8.00am for breakfast.</b> Students will be leaving school at 9.15am and returning to school at 3.00pm
STAFF ATTENDING:	Jane Hart and Lisa Durham with support staff.
TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS:	Students will be travelling to and from the venue by Driver Coastal Bus Service
STUDENT INDEMNITY:	By signing the payment envelope I understand that I have given my authority for the teacher in charge of the excursion to consent, where it is impracticable to communicate with me, to the child receiving such medical or surgical treatment as may be deemed necessary and payment of any expenses thus incurred.
FURTHER INFORMATION:	Students will <b>NOT</b> be required to wear full school uniforms. They should wear runners (closed in toe shoes) and loose pants or shorts that are suitable for outdoor sports and activities. T-shirts or shirts must have sleeves (no singlet tops allowed). Please ensure your child is dressed for the weather forecast for the day. They will need a hat and sunscreen and may need a waterproof coat.  Breakfast will be provided by school, please complete the form below & return to school. Students will need lunch, play-lunch and a water bottle, which they can bring in their own backpack or schoolbag.
STUDENT BEHAVIOUR:	I understand that in the event of my son's/daughter's misbehaviour or behaviour that poses a danger to himself/herself or others during the excursion, he/she may be sent home. I further understand that in such circumstances I will be informed and that any costs associated with his/her return will be my responsibility.
CONSENT TO EMERGENCY TRANSPORTATION:	In the event of an emergency I consent to my child being transported in a privately owned vehicle driven by a member of the supervisory staff.
STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE:	The Department of Education does not provide student accident cover including ambulance cover. Parents may wish to obtain student accident insurance cover from a commercial insurer, depending on their health insurance arrangements and any other personal considerations. Parents are also advised to ensure that they have ambulance cover as the school will not hesitate in calling an ambulance if required
