EXCURSION DETAILS:	<i>The Grade 5/6's will attend an excursion to Cranbourne Botanic Gardens to participate in an exploration of local flora and fauna habitats. Students will learn about how living things adapt to survive in hot, dry deserts and the causes of desertification. They will pot up a drought tolerant plant and examine the features that Australian plants have evolved to allow them to conserve water.</i>

STUDENT INDEMNITY:	By signing the payment envelope I understand that I have given my authority for the teacher in charge of the excursion to consent, where it is impracticable to communicate with me, to the child receiving such medical or surgical treatment as may be deemed necessary and payment of any expenses thus incurred.
FURTHER INFORMATION:	Full school Uniform. Full enclosed footwear, including appropriate clothing according to the weather (i.e. water proof jacket in school colours, walking shoes) Students will also need to bring a packed lunch, snacks & drinks.
STUDENT BEHAVIOUR:	I understand that in the event of my son's/daughter's misbehaviour or behaviour that poses a danger to himself/herself or others during the excursion, he/she may be sent home. I further understand that in such circumstances I will be informed and that any costs associated with his/her return will be my responsibility.
CONSENT TO EMERGENCY TRANSPORTATION:	In the event of an emergency I consent to my child being transported in a privately owned vehicle driven by a member of the supervisory staff listed above.
STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE:	The Department of Education does not provide student accident cover including ambulance cover. Parents may wish to obtain student accident insurance cover from a commercial insurer, depending on their health insurance arrangements and any other personal considerations. Parents are also advised to ensure that they have ambulance cover as the school will not hesitate in calling an ambulance if required
