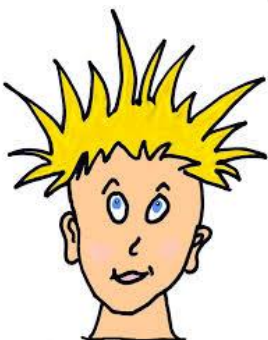
When: Crazy hair/Troll day is on Thursday 25th May
