EXCURSION DETAILS:	Students in grades 3 and 4 will participate in an excursion to the Mount Martha Surf Lifesaving Club (MMLSC) as part of their outdoor/aquatic education program. Surf Lifesaving guards have been employed to supervise the water activities. The cost is higher than the 5/6 Day due to a smaller number of students.

DEPARTURE/RETURN TIMES:	Students will be leaving school at 9.10am and returning to school by 3.00pm

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS:	Students will be travelling to and from the venue by Driver Bus Service.
STUDENT INDEMNITY:	By signing the payment envelope I understand that I have given my authority for the teacher in charge of the excursion to consent, where it is impracticable to communicate with me, to the child receiving such medical or surgical treatment as may be deemed necessary and payment of any expenses thus incurred.
FURTHER INFORMATION:	Students must wear school uniform , but will be required to bring bathers, towel, lycra sun smart top/t-shirt , hat, sunscreen, water bottle, morning tea and cut lunch all in a day bag.
STUDENT BEHAVIOUR:	I understand that in the event of my son's/daughter's misbehaviour or behaviour that poses a danger to himself/herself or others during the excursion, he/she may be sent home. I further understand that in such circumstances I will be informed and that any costs associated with his/her return will be my responsibility.
CONSENT TO EMERGENCY TRANSPORTATION:	In the event of an emergency I consent to my child being transported in a privately owned vehicle driven by a member of the supervisory staff listed above.
STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE:	The Department of Education does not provide student accident cover including ambulance cover. Parents may wish to obtain student accident insurance cover from a commercial insurer, depending on their health insurance arrangements and any other personal considerations. Parents are also advised to ensure that they have ambulance cover as the school will not hesitate in calling an ambulance if required
