Name suggestion	Meaning
Booboop	child
Monomeeth	precious
Djilak-djirri - sounds like 'Jill-ack JIRRY'	play/explore
Oordiyalyal - oo as in book	lots or many
Mung mung – sounds like 'moong moong'	remember
Ngarn-ga - quietly pronounce the n as g is main sound)	hear and understand
Mirambeena	you
Thooamee – sounds like thooaMEE	listen
Bullarto jumbunna	great talking

All responses will go into a raffle, where one of our students will have the opportunity to be involved in the ceremonies involved when we officially rename our building in Term 2.
