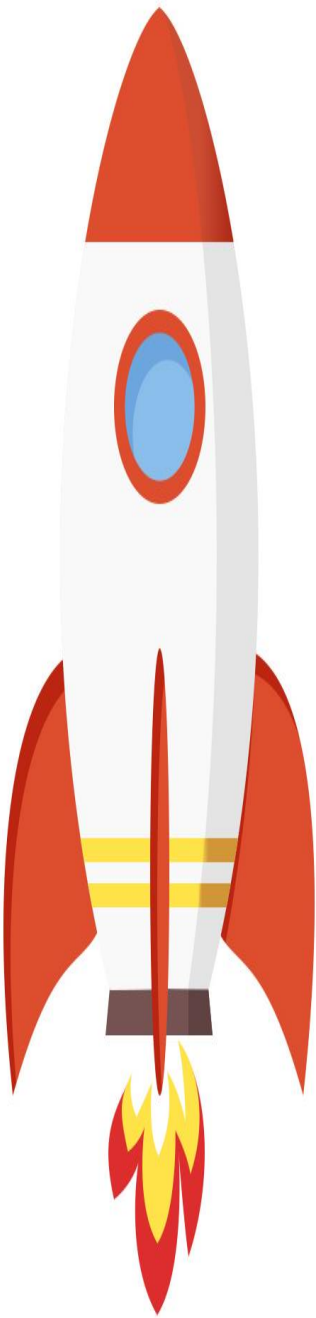


Our School Values

Positive Behaviour Reinforcement



1. The students begin each day ready to learn. They will clip their peg onto the chart at the beginning of each day.

2. When students are making good choices they can be instructed by the teacher to 'clip up'

Examples might include but are not exclusive to:

- Sitting quietly on the floor
- Helping others
- Being organised
- Completing work
- Having a go
- Showing persistence
- Bouncing back from mistakes
- Respectful behaviour
- Displaying school values of respect, integrity, service and empathy

These targeted behaviours may differ for each student.

3. At the end of the day, those students who made it to outstanding receive a line on the back of their peg. 5 lines = 1 gem. 5 gems = Teacher gets to wear their peg for the day.

4. If needed, a 'clip down' may be required for undesired behaviour. As this chart aims at reinforcing positive behaviour, opportunities should be there for the student to make amends and clip back up the chart.

5. Please take a note of those who made it to Outstanding (or were clipped down below Ready to Learn) for the classroom teacher.
